6. Audit of the Central Ballot Scanners

This Audit will take place in Manhattan at the Borough Voting Machine Facility (See Schedule B) on Friday, November 20, 2020 at 1:00 PM. Please check with the respective Borough Chief Clerk/Deputy Chief Clerk to confirm the date and time for the commencement of this activity. As a candidate, you or your representative designated in writing may be present and observe the audit of the central ballot scanners.

7. Canvass and or Re-canvass of Votes Cast of Election Day Paper Ballots

Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 9-206 and 9-208 of the NYS Election Law, you or your representative designated in writing may be present and observe the re-canvass of votes cast on the Poll Site Voting Systems during Early Voting and

on Election Day and the canvass of any and all write-in votes cast on the Poll Site Voting Systems. This re-canvass will commence on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>November 4, 2020 no earlier than 10:00 AM</u> and will continue until such recanvass of all of the Poll Site Voting Systems has been completed including Saturdays and Sundays, if necessary.
