RCV Manual Recanvass

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 9-200 and Section 9-208 of the New York State Election Law, you or your representative designated in writing may be present and observe the RCV manual recanvass of all votes cast in the 9th Council District.

This recanvass will commence on **Monday, July 26, 2021 from 10:00 AM to 8:00 PM** and will continue until completed, including Saturdays from **10:00 AM to 5:00 PM**, if necessary. The Board of Elections will have teams of bi-partisan staff conducting the recanvass. You may appoint one watcher to observe each bi-partisan team. This recanvass will take place in Manhattan at **450 West 33rd Street, 8th Floor, New York, New York 10001**

Please check with the Borough Chief Clerk/Deputy Chief Clerk to confirm the date and time for the commencement of this activity, and/or if you have any questions or require additional information.
